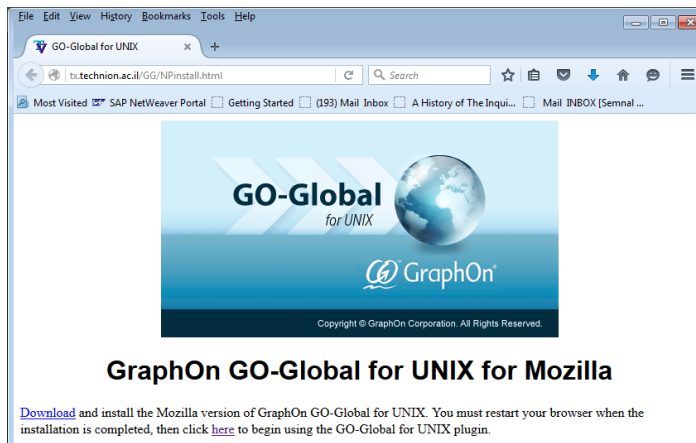


## Go-Global Version 2.3.0 Installation Instructions

**Note:** The first time you run Go-Global from your MS Windows, you must be logged in as system administrator or have the permissions of the system administrators group.

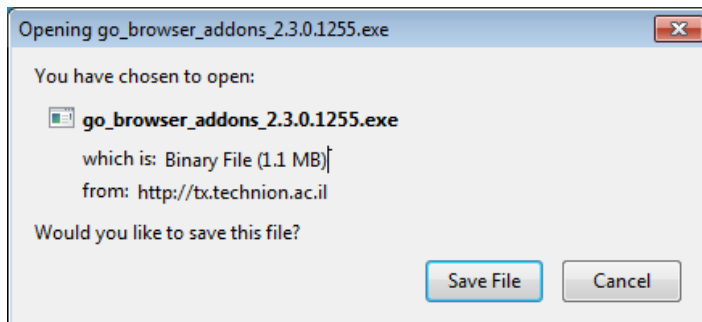
### Steps for Installing and using GoGlobal from within Mozilla Firefox:

- 1) Open the Web site: <http://technion.ac.il/GG>

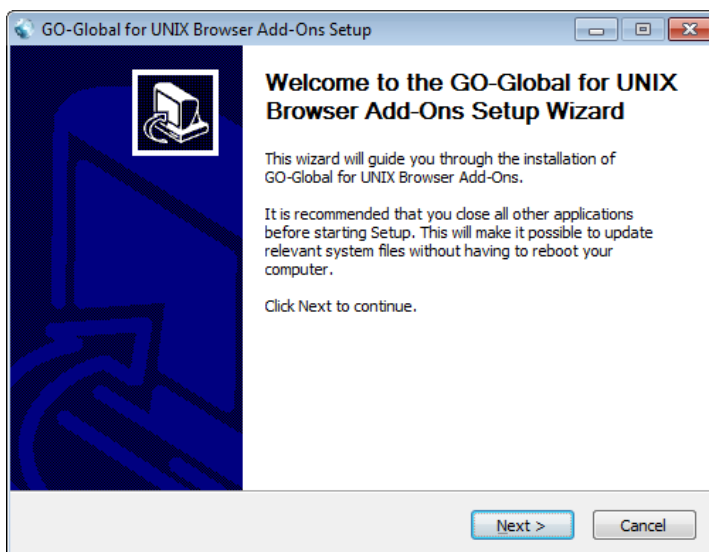


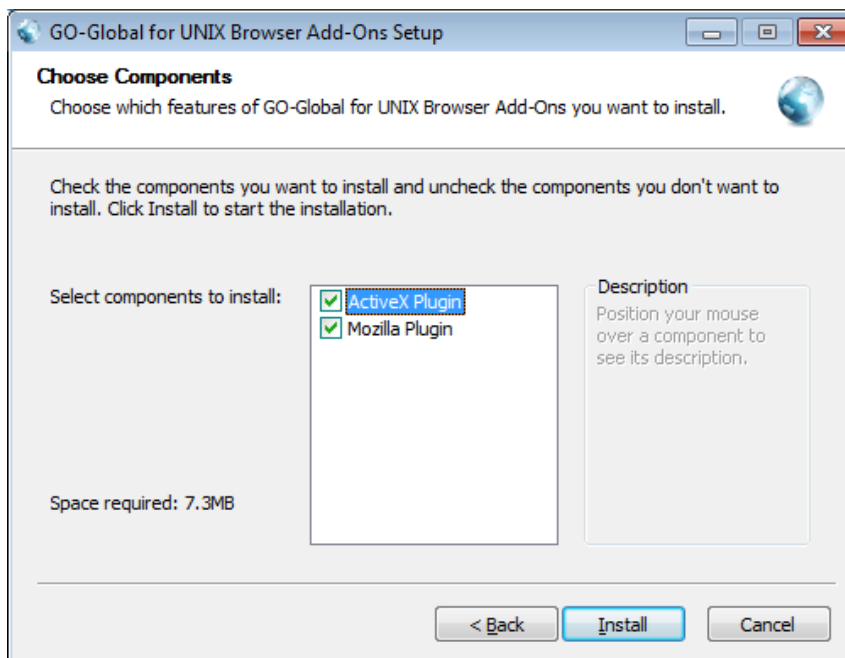
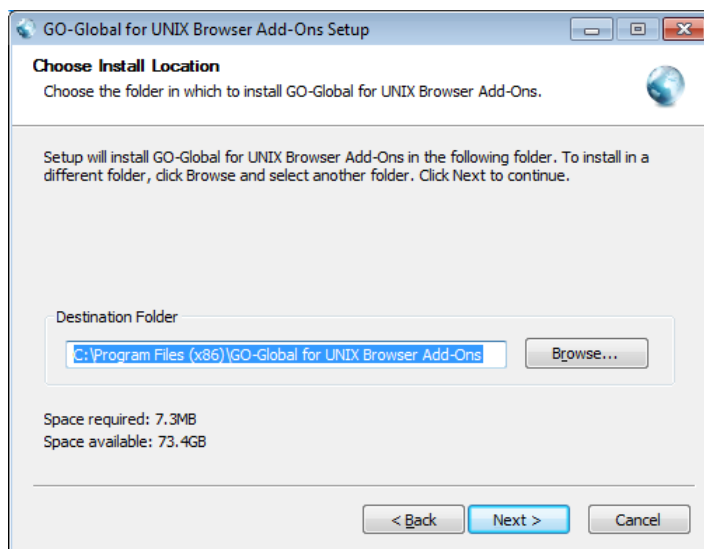
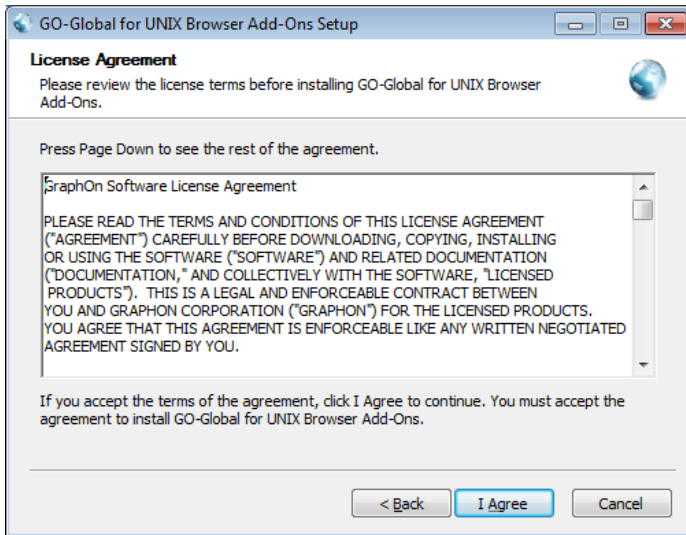
- 2) Press “Download”.

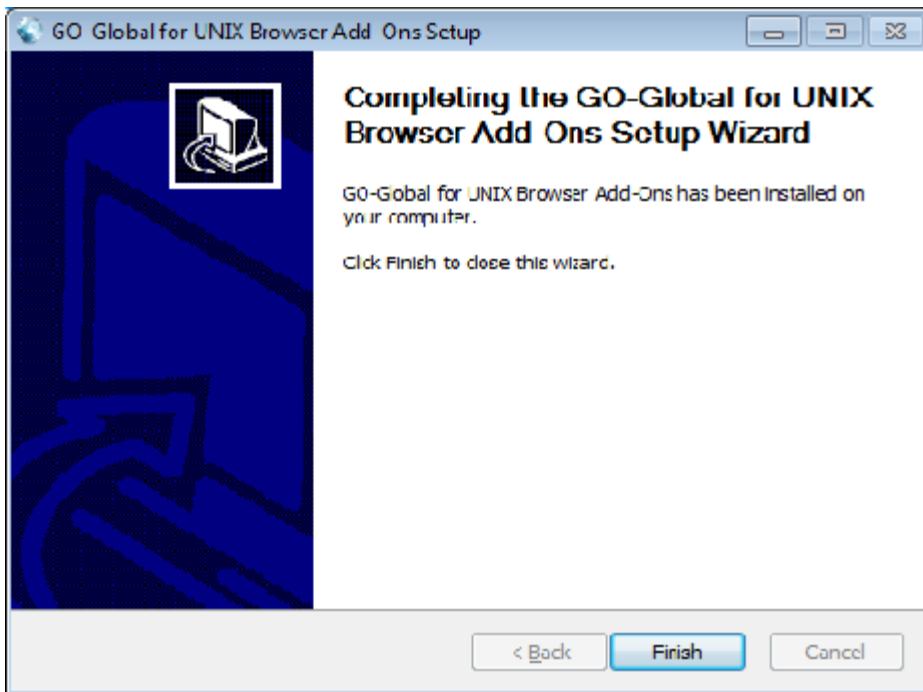
- 3) Save the file **go\_browser\_addons\_2.3.0.1255.exe** in the **temp** directory on drive C:/



- 4) Double-click on the file name to run it and follow default steps of the installation wizard:







5) By default, GoGlobal plugin installs itself in the directory

[C:\Program Files \(x86\)\GO-Global for UNIX Browser Add-Ons](#)

Go this directory and double-click on the file **goglobal\_ux** to open the GoGlobal Connection panel. It is recommended to create Shortcut for [goglobal\\_ux](#) on your Desktop.

6) Choose **Secure Socket** in the **Transport** text box of the Connection panel

7) Choose **aluf.technion.ac.il** (or your faculty server name) in the **Server Address** text box, and press **Connect**

8) Click "Yes" in the "Security Alert" panel



9) enter your **Username** and **Password** on the server in the **Authentication** panel and press **OK**.

10) In the GoGlobal for Unix Window which opens then, double-click **Xterm** icon to open Unix terminal. You can drag-and-drop the Xterm icon to your Desktop to create the Shortcut for specific server.

11) If you wish to use GoGlobal on different server, or you change your password, click on the [goglobal\\_ux](#) Shortcut and repeat the **Connection** and **Authentication** procedure (items 6 to 9).
